- Grading traffic climate (scale 4-10, with 4 poor, 10 excellent)

Positive characteristics

- Politeness and flexibility
- Caution while passing
- Abiding by the rules of traffic
- Friendliness and helpfulness
- Adjusting to traffic jams
- Taking care of safety
- Thanking others
- Respecting others' rights

Negative characteristics

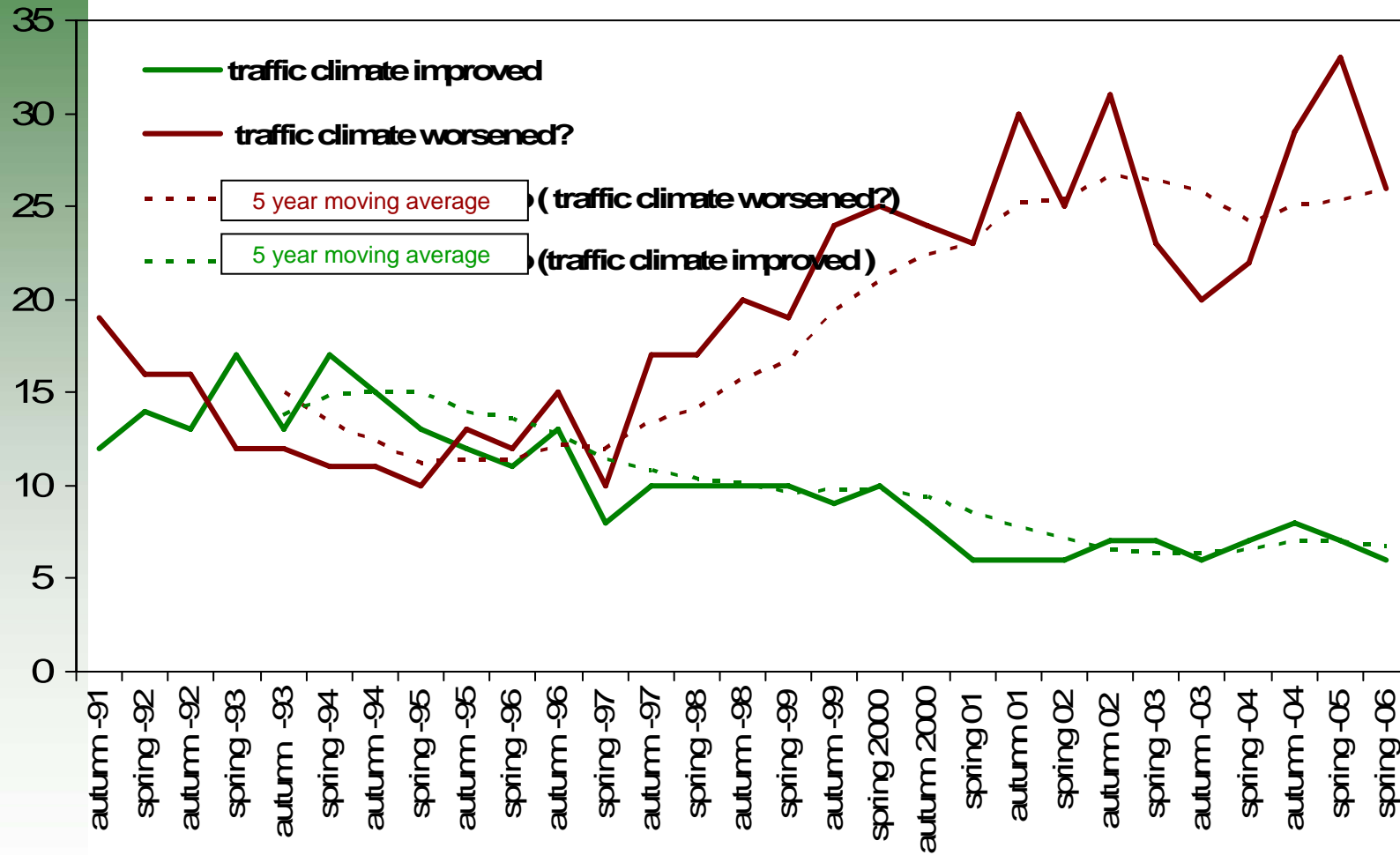
- Speeding
- Cutting in
- Intimidating traffic
- Selfish driving habits
- Restlessness in traffic jams
- Tailgating
- Disregard for rules
- Taking risks while passing
- Causing harm on purpose

Other questions:

- has traffic made you feel irritated with increased or decreased frequency
 - how often have you yourself behaved this way (negative characteristics) in traffic
- + current questions

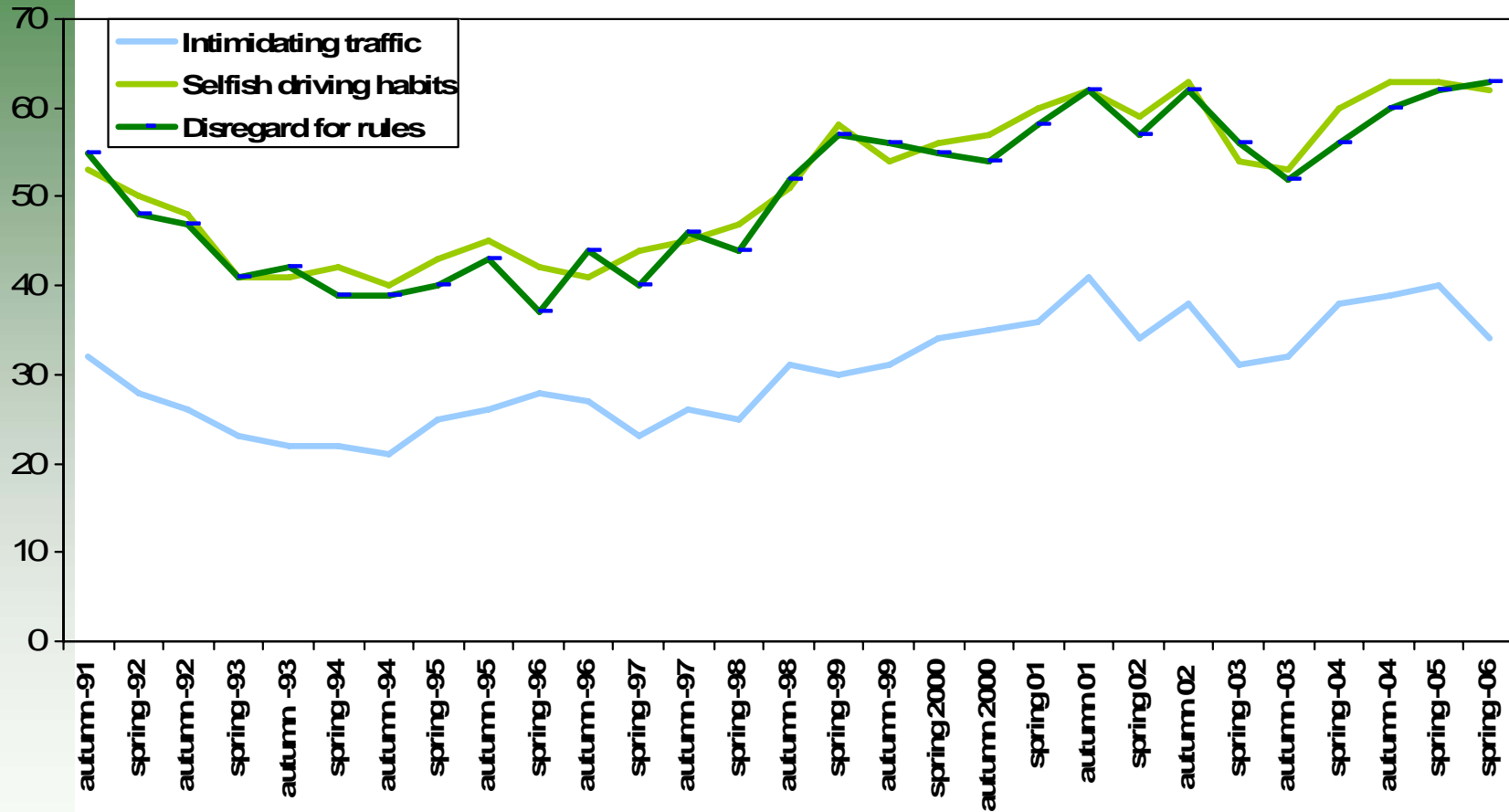
Traffic climate is based on interviews conducted by TNS Gallup. The sample is representative of the Finnish population over 15 years of age (with automobile questions, age 18) with the exception of Åland. There are about 1,000 interviewed drivers per polling session.
